## HONOURING THE HELPING HANDS:

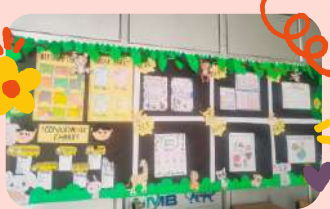
